## **PERSONAL BIOGRAPHY**

Sylvain Horn was born in Maastricht, December 3, 1883, where he was born as one of seven children of Cesar Horn and Marianne Bloemgarten. Sylvain, like his other brothers, worked as a meat trader in his own shop in Maastricht. At the age of 24 (11-12-1907), he married Flora Wijngaard, who was born in Maastricht, in October 29, 1883. She was the youngest of six children of Moses Levi Wijngaard and Rachel Houtman. Sylvain and Flora had 5 children: Henri (centre), who died because of a liver disease in 1939, Cesar (right), who went into hiding during the war, Fritz (left), who served in the British Army during the war, Rachel Horn (left, mother of Mr. Altman), and Annie Horn, who was the youngest.

Sylvain, Flora and Annie were deported from Maastricht in August 25, 1942. On August 31, 1942, they were murdered in Auschwitz. Sylvain and Flora reached the age of 58, and Annie of 22.
